Geared at supporting pre-professional, rural, youth creatives who are considering entering the arts + cultural workforce, STUDIO is your local place to explore creative expression while getting professional and pre-college support from rural folks already working in the industry.

**Who:** Students age 15 to 17 (exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis) working with support from Amador Arts staff and volunteers

**What: STUDIO**, which is short for “student-directed opportunities” is a free space with free art supplies for youth to have individualized support for their self-directed creative goals and volunteerism in arts + culture.

**Where:** The Amador County Arts Council, 110 Broad Street (inside the Historic Grammar School with access via Randolph Street to Fullen Street) in downtown Sutter Creek.

**When:** Tuesdays from 3 to 5 PM.

**How:** Please read, complete, sign, and return this STUDIO Registration Form to Amador Arts staff. Once received, staff will reach out to confirm participation. **Contact Amador Arts via text/call to (209)256-8166 or by email to info@amadorarts.org.**
